



TERMS of COMPETITION for the SCRATCH FOURSOMES

Scratch Foursomes Stroke Play

1. Each club may enter one team into the stroke play qualifying event.
2. Teams returning the 8 lowest gross scores will qualify for the Match Play stages of the competition.

Scratch Foursomes Match Play

1. Following completion of the qualifying competition a seeded draw will take place and be published on the website.
2. The Competitions Committee will determine the venues and play by dates for the Match Play stages of the competition.
3. The quarter and semi-finals of the competition will be over 18 holes. If after 18 holes the match is tied, then sudden death will occur to determine a winner.
4. The final will be played over 36 holes on the date, time and at the venue set out in the fixture list.
5. On completion of the quarter and semi-finals the winning pair should communicate the result to the Competitions Secretary.
6. Where a result is not provided by the play by date then both teams will be disqualified

There are no prizes for the qualifying competition.

The Match Play Champions will receive the shield to hold for a year.
