



TERMS of COMPETITION for the HANDICAP FOURSOMES

Handicap Foursomes Stroke Play

1. Each club may enter one team which may be mixed into the stroke play qualifying event.
2. The Handicap Index range is 6.0 to 14.9.
3. To represent their club competitors must have a minimum of 20 scores on their handicap record of which 8 must have been played under competition rules and have been played in the previous 12 calendar months prior to the date of the competition.
4. Players with a higher Handicap Index (HI) may play but for the purposes of calculating their Playing Handicap a maximum HI of 14.9 must be used.
5. In the Stroke play qualifying event the handicap allowance is 50% of the combined Playing Handicap.
6. Teams returning the 8 lowest nett scores will qualify for the Match Play stages of the competition.

Handicap Foursomes Match Play

7. Following completion of the qualifying competition a seeded draw will take place and be published on the website.
8. The Competitions Committee will determine the venues and play by dates for the Match Play stages of the competition.
9. The quarter and semi-finals of the competition will be over 18 holes. If after 18 holes the match is tied, then sudden death will be played to determine a winner.
10. In the match play stages the players representing their clubs must have a minimum of 20 scores on their handicap record of which 8 must have been played under competition rules and have been played in the previous 12 calendar months prior to the date of the competition.
11. In the match play stages of the competition a stroke allowance of 50% of the difference between the combined Playing Handicaps will be given.





12. The final will be played over 36 holes on the date, time and at the venue set out in the fixture list.
13. On completion of the quarter and semi-finals the winning pair should communicate the result to the Competitions Secretary.
14. Where a result is not provided by the play by date then both teams will be disqualified

PRIZES

The team returning the lowest nett score in the qualifying competition will receive a voucher.

The Champions will receive a shield to hold for a year.

Vouchers will be given to:

- The Winners
- The Runners Up
- The winners of the qualifying competition

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
